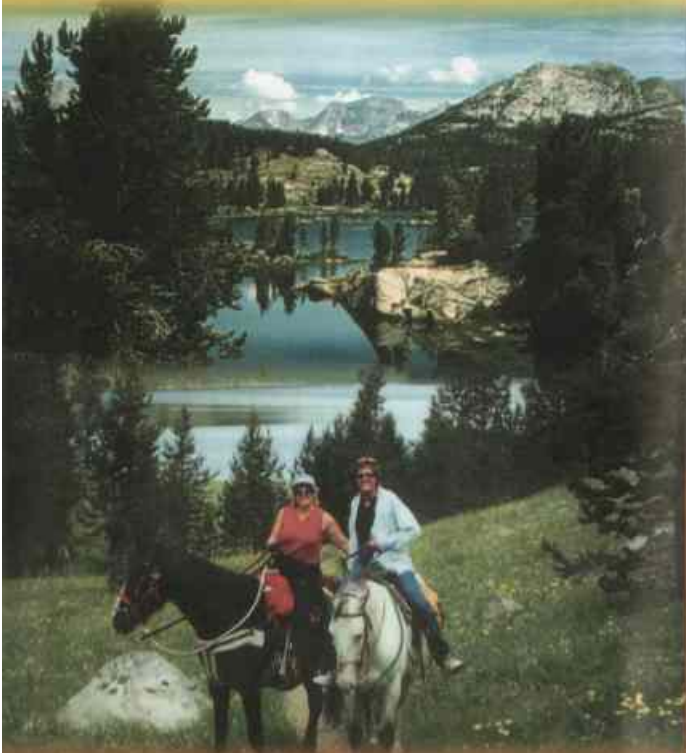


Spot Pack Trips / Gear Drop

Guided Pack Trips

Travel from Big Sandy Opening in the Bridger National Forest and Wilderness Area and enjoy excellent trout fishing, spectacular alpine scenery and secluded camping in breathtaking surroundings. We furnish all supplies, equipment, wrangler/guide, cook and horses. Bring your personal gear, sleeping bag, fishing equipment and camera. Your trip is planned to meet your specifications.



Guest Corral Rental

Should you choose to stay and bring your own horses, we have corrals available on a first come first served basis, guest provides feed and care, water is available. Horses coming from out of state need to have proper health certificates.



Deposits / Refund Policy

We require a 1/3 deposit to confirm your reservation. The balance of the fee is due upon your arrival at Big Sandy Lodge. If you cancel your reservations at least 30 days prior to the scheduled arrival date, we will refund 50% of your deposit. No refunds with less than 30 days notice.

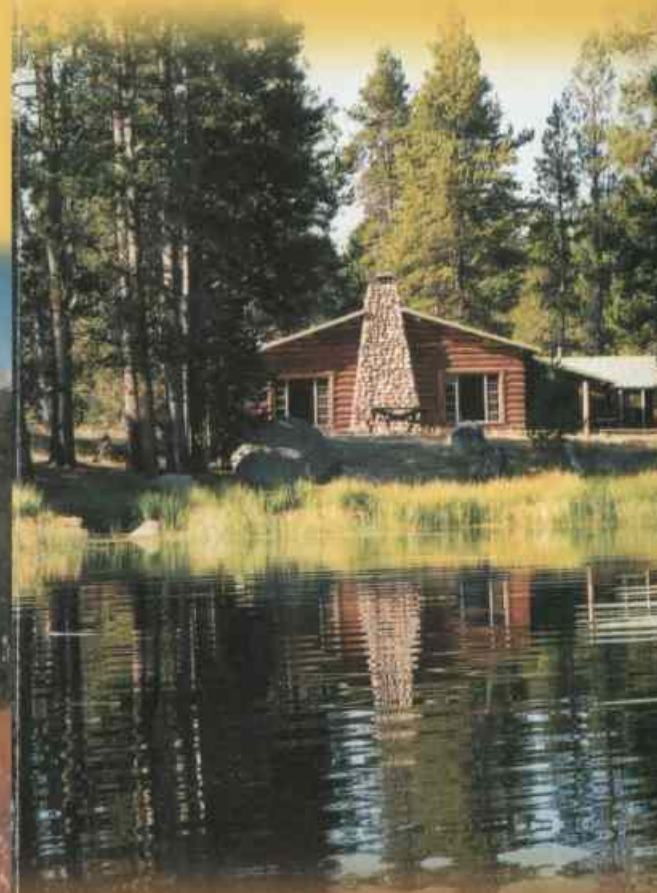

Big Sandy Lodge is remotely located at the end of the Big Sandy opening road, 44 miles from the town of Boulder Wyoming in a very rustic setting, nestled in the Wind River Range of the Bridger National Forest at an elevation of 9100 feet, 1 mile from the Bridger Wilderness. There are no public phones or electricity at the Lodge. Originally established in 1929 as a tent camp by Finis Mitchell, well known "Man O' The Mountain" and author of the hiking book "Wind River Trails". The area has changed little since then. It offers a variety of opportunities for outdoor enthusiasts of all types in majestic alpine settings.

Big Sandy Lodge offers a variety of family and individual vacation packages, as well as 10 rental cabins that can accommodate up to 44 people. Enjoy our hearty western meals served family style in our lodge, guided trail rides, guided pack trips, spot pack trips, fishing, hiking and photographic opportunities. We cater to family reunions, weddings and organized groups. Our lodge has massive twin native stone fireplaces and a trophy filled lounge for your enjoyment. Spend your evenings in front of a roaring fire, watch the sun set over our alpine lake and the mountains of the Continental Divide, and feel the evening quiet.



From the Lodge, the Big Sandy, Fremont, Lowline and Highline Trails will take you to 40 different lakes within 15 miles of the Lodge. Most of these are within eight miles and offer some of the most majestic breathtaking views of the Wind River Range, including the Famed "Cirque at the Towers". Six different species of Trout are available for the avid angler. So, whether you're hiking, mountain climbing, fishing, hunting or looking for photographic opportunities, let us help you plan a vacation to fit your schedule.

Commercial flights arrive daily in Rock Springs, Riverton and Jackson, WY and Salt Lake City, UT. Rental cars are available. Shuttle service is available from Jackson and Pinedale, WY.



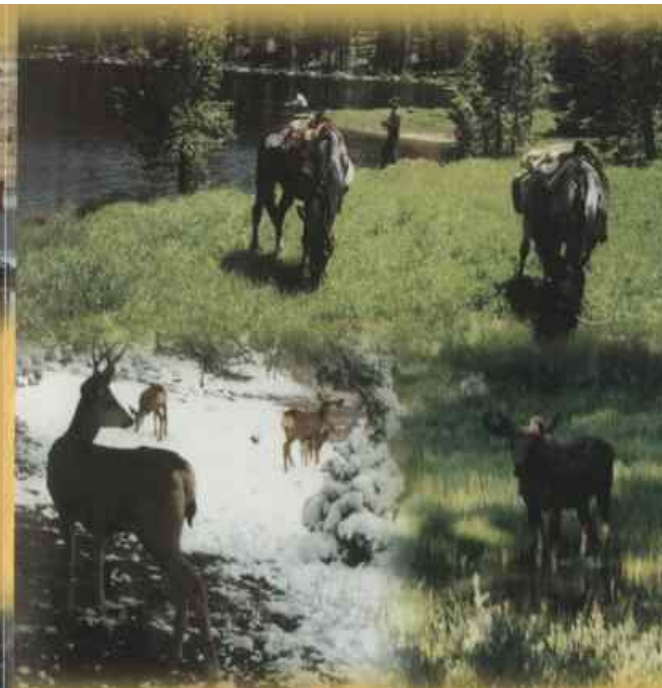
Cabins
